

1. In this Act, the “principal Act” means the Goods and Services Tax Act, 2021 (Act No. 18/2021).

OBJECTS AND REASONS

(The Objects and Reasons do not form part of the Bill)

This Bill seeks to amend the Goods and Services Tax Act to make the current exemption on the supply of fuel in Anguilla specifically gasoline, diesel and liquid propane gas permanent. Previously, the supply of fuel was exempt from the Goods and Services Tax for a period of 1 year from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023.
